Ash Wednesday marks the beginning of the penitential season of Lent. Lent is a solemn season in which we focus on prayer, fasting, and almsgiving as means to draw near to God.

The Imposition of Ashes will be offered tonight. You will be invited to come forward and receive a cross of ashes on your forehead as a symbol of your repentance and faith. Participation is optional.

Holy Communion will be celebrated this evening. All who are baptized into Christ and believe that he is really present in, with, and under the bread and wine for the forgiveness of their sins are welcome to join us at the altar.

To those with young children: We are very happy you are here today. Relax and enjoy your time here. Jesus knows that children tend to

wiggle and squawk a bit, so please don't be embarrassed by it! Encourage your kids to sing and pray with us, and be sure to sing and pray your parts as an example to them.

A children's sermon will be given for any kids who want to come forward.

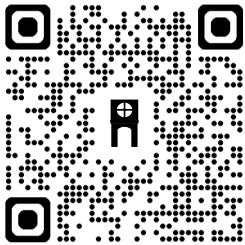
