About Today's Service

Palm Sunday remembers the triumphal procession of Jesus into Jerusalem, which fulfilled the Scriptures and proclaimed him as the coming Messiah. But the crowd's cheering soon turns to calls to "crucify him!" as Jesus is arrested, tried, and executed on a Roman cross. We call the suffering and death of Jesus **"The Passion."**

Holy Communion will be celebrated today. All who are

baptized into Christ and believe that he is really present in, with, and under the bread and wine for the forgiveness of their sins are welcome to join us at the altar.

To those with young children: We are very happy you are here today. Relax and enjoy your time here. Jesus knows that children tend to wiggle and squawk a bit, so please don't be embarrassed by it! Encourage your kids to sing and

pray with us, and be sure to sing and pray your parts as an example to them.

A children's sermon will be given for any kids who want to come forward.
