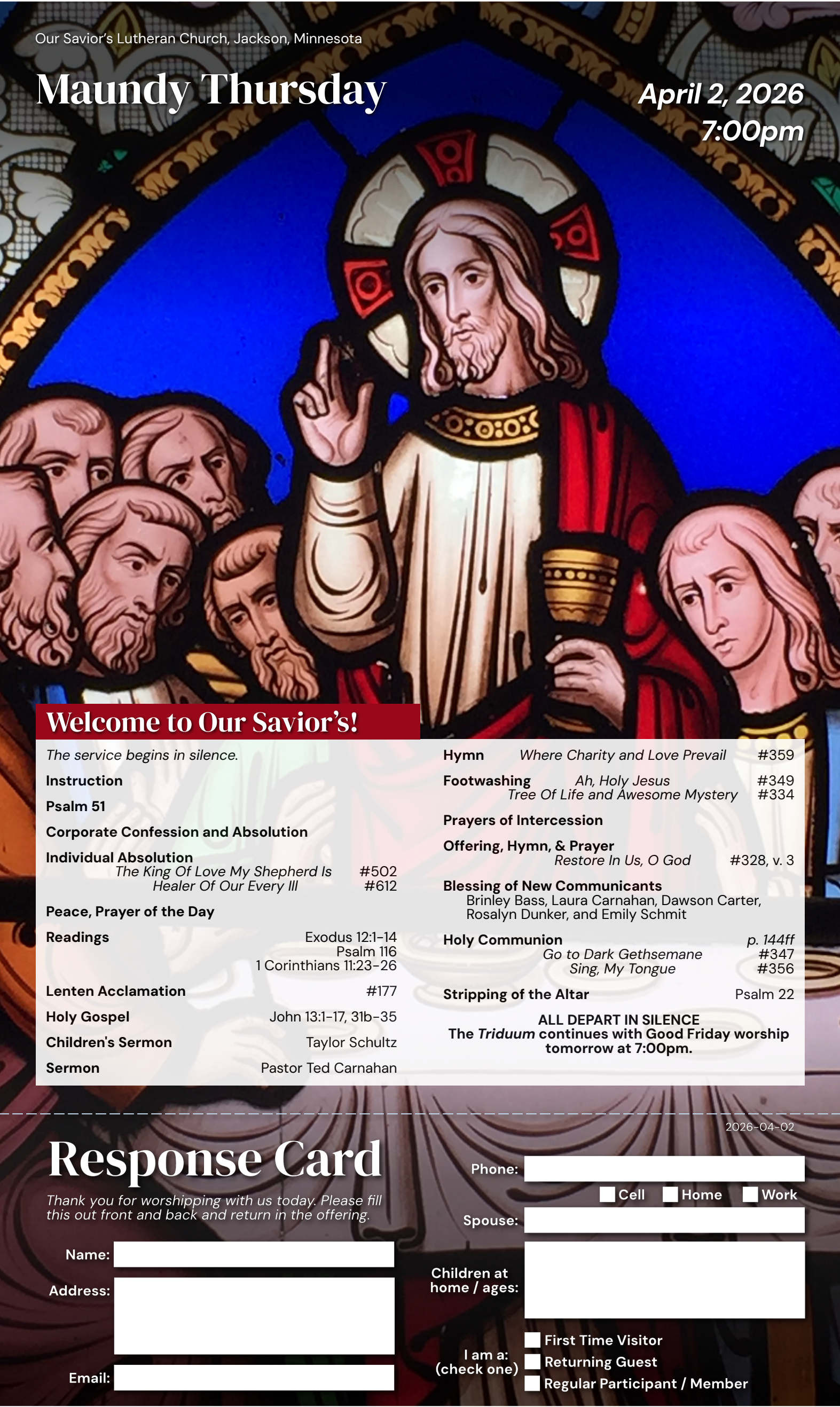

About this Maundy Thursday service

Maundy Thursday begins the *Triduum*, or the Great "Three Days" of our Lord's suffering, death, and resurrection. This evening's worship recounts the compassion and love of Jesus Christ at the Last Supper. He gives us his command to "love one another as he has loved us."

Individual Confession and Absolution offers the assurance of forgiveness for each individual in particular. Participation is optional.

Footwashing is a ritual that recalls Jesus' willingness to put himself into the position of a slave by washing his disciples' feet. As

Christians, we are called to place ourselves last and to be servants to all people. Participation is optional.

First Communion will be recognized for the five young people who have completed instruction in the Sacrament of the Altar.

Holy Communion will be celebrated this evening. All who are baptized into Christ and believe that he is really present in, with, and under the bread and wine for the forgiveness of their sins are welcome to join us at the altar.

To those with young children: We are very happy you are here today. Relax and enjoy your time here. Jesus knows that children tend to wiggle and squawk a bit, so please don't be embarrassed by it! Encourage your kids to sing and pray with us, and be sure to sing and pray your parts as an example to them.

A children's sermon will be given for any kids who want to come forward.

There are also activity bags for kids on the wooden tree just outside the Centrum doors.
