About this Good Friday service

Good Friday continues the *Triduum*, or the Great "Three Days" of our Lord's suffering, death, and resurrection. This evening's worship recounts the death of Jesus Christ upon the cross for us, for the forgiveness of our sins.

The Solemn Reproaches will conclude tonight's service. They are an ancient text of Western Christendom associated with Good Friday. These reproaches, or accusations, from the perspective of Christ highlight that it is our sin,

individually and collectively, which made the death of Christ upon the cross necessary. Our response to each reproach is the ancient *Trisagion*, or thrice-holy: "Holy God, holy and mighty, holy and immortal, have mercy on us."
